New Hampshire is famous for its picturesque lakes and mountains and Squam Lake is truly a gem among many. We'll begin our visit on the ³/₄ mile Live Animal Exhibit Trail which winds up and down through the various habitats. You'll see a mountain lion, bobcat, white-tailed deer, river otters, black bear, many birds and a raptor exhibit. There are numerous places along the trail to sit and rest. Beautiful Kirkwood Gardens await you at the halfway point of the trail.
