



Graduate Certificate in College Teaching

Students must be formally admitted to the Certificate program. A maximum of 2 courses taken prior to matriculation (enrollment in the program after admission) may be applied to fulfill requirements in the Certificate. Go to the Graduate School for application information.

The Certificate requires the satisfactory completion of 12 academic credits including 8 credits in core courses and 4 credits in elective courses. Below is a listing of the required and elective courses for the Graduate Certificate in College Teaching:
