- Review class schedule- are there any changes we need to make?

- Register for and take the PSAT (ETS provides a fee waiver)
- Begin to research colleges & career interests
- Work hard academically, taking a rigorous curriculum

November/December

- Talk to your parents about college
- Begin creating a list of colleges in which you would like to apply
- Begin to prepare for the SAT exams
- Continue to work hard academically

January/February

- Learn about federal financial aid programs and scholarships
- Continue to research colleges and learn about the college admissions process
- Plan senior year courses
- Research summer programs & opportunities

March/April

- Visit colleges and continue to research the colleges on your list
- Take the SAT (this is the required state test in NH)
- Create a Common Application Account

May/June

- teachers who might write a letter of recommendation for college & start your "brag sheet."
- Begin to finalize your college list
- Write a first draft of your college essay
- Review SAT scores & decide if you want to take them again (ETS has a fee waiver)
- Visit colleges over the summer
- Get a job or volunteer opportunity for the summer
