



How to Link Test Scores to Kahn Academy

Official SAT Practice helps students focus on exactly what they need to work on most. There are two ways to get personalized practice: Students can link their College Board and Khan Academy accounts to send their scores from the PSAT/NMSQT, PSAT 10, PSAT 8/9, or SAT; or, if students don't have scores to share, they can take diagnostic quizzes.

Option A: Students Share Their Test Results

Send students to satpractice.org to share their scores and get a personalized SAT study plan based on results from the PSAT/NMSQT, PSAT 10, PSAT 8/9, or SAT.

How Students Link Their College Board and Khan Academy Accounts:

1. Go to satpractice.org. Create an account on Khan Academy or sign in to their existing account.
2. When prompted, agree to link their Khan Academy and College Board accounts.
3. Send their scores.
