FAQ for those noncompliant for the immunization requirement

Q. What immunizations am I not compliant with?

A. Log onto your <u>MyHealth&Wellness</u> account

To log on use your UNH AD username and password

Navigate to "Medical Clearances"

Example below: Will list immunizations out and will list their status. This will show them exactly what they are missing.

Items required for clearance:



Q. I uploaded my immunization record why am I not compliant?

A. If you uploaded them, please log on to your portal and check your clearances. You may have uploaded your record, but it may not have everything that is required.

Q. I don't have a record of my immunizations.

A. Please call your doctor's office to get a copy of your records. If you don't have a doctor or they have closed, call your high school and ask for your immunization documentation.

If they have no records but they have received the vaccines, they can make an appointment at Health & Wellness to have titers drawn

Q. I am an international student and don't have all my immunizations.

A. Walmart in Newington have all the required vaccines

Rite Aid in Durham can give the MMR vaccine.

Q. I did not upload my immunizations because I need a medical or religious exemption.

A. Please go to <u>https://www.unh.edu/health/health-requirements</u>
For a medical exemption they need to complete our form and a medical provider's statement.

For religious they need to complete our form.

These forms need to be uploaded into their portal for approval.

Q. I am having trouble uploading my immunizations

Check to make sure your file type is accepted.

Log out and try again

If you still cannot upload them, you can email them to health@unh.edu

Q. I only have my immunizations on my doctor's form not UNH's form.

You can upload your doctor's form it does not have to be the UNH form.

Q. I am a first-year graduate student and did my undergraduate at UNH. I didn't have to complete this requirement my freshman year do I need to do it now?

A. Yes, if you have not completed this requirement in your undergraduate time you will need to complete it now.
